Rachelle is a 33 year old (DOB: 09/27/1980) female who initiated a VZVirtual Visit for evaluation of bronchitis.


Her symptoms started **10-13 days ago** and consist of cough, fever, rhinitis, hoarse voice, chills.

She denies nasal congestion, post-nasal drainage, chest pain, vomiting, malaise, nausea, anorexia, sore throat, ear pain, myalgias. she denies dyspnea and dysphagia, petechial or purpuric rash and shortness of breath. She denies a history of facial surgery.

Her minimal nasal secretions are white. When asked to feel her neck she denied feeling enlarged lymph nodes. She denies axillary lymphadenopathy.

Her moderately severe (cough every 5-10 minutes) non-productive aparoxysmal cough is NOT more bothersome at night. She has NOT tried medications to help the cough.

Her hightest temperature was: 100. She has passed urine in the past 12 hours. She denies rigors.


Dear Rachelle,

Based on the information you have provided, you likely have acute bronchitis.

I am prescribing benzonatate (Tessalon Perles) 100 mg to treat your cough. Take one to two tablets by mouth three times a day as needed for cough. There are no refills with this prescription.

I am prescribing an antibiotic **Azithromycin** to help you feel better. Azithromycin comes as a 250 mg tablet. Swallow two (2) tablets on the first day then one tablet a day for days 2-5. There is no refill with this prescription.

Drink plenty of liquids, especially water and take time to rest your body. This may mean taking a nap or going to bed earlier. Your body is fighting an infection and liquids and rest will improve the pace of recovery. Remember to regularly wash your hands and avoid close contact with others to prevent spreading your infection.


